

Cleaning and Maintenance of Mirrors

- General cleaning or cleaning water spots -

Before attempting to clean the mirror, use compressed air (i.e Dust Off which can be found in most photographic stores) to make sure that all dust and debris are off the mirror.

You can use an optical grade cleaning cloth (no lint) and Windex.

Apply Windex to cloth until cloth is damp (saturated) but not dripping.

Clean the mirror in one direction then stroke using a fresh part of the cloth after each pass.

- Repair of Dimples on Mirrors -

Use a heat gun (350 degree temperature) can be used to remove "dimples" from the mirror. Hold heat gun 1/2 "- 1" from the mirror. Move in a circular fashion working towards the outside edge. This should remove the dimples.
